

Protect the fruit and foliage from Citrus Aphis. Spray with "Black Leaf 40" while the foliage is young and the infestation is light. Prevent injury to new growth, especially while trees are in bloom. For more than 30 years "Black Leaf 40" has been the standby of particular growers.
