

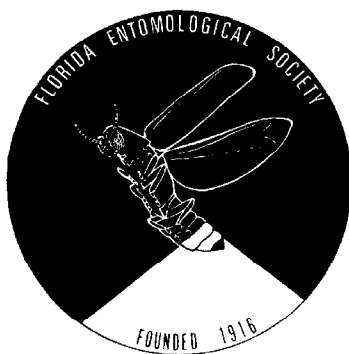

THE FLORIDA ENTOMOLOGIST is issued quarterly—March, June, September, and December. Subscription price to non-members \$15.00 per year in advance, \$3.75 per copy. Entered as second class matter at the post office at Gainesville, Florida.

Manuscripts and other editorial matter should be sent to the Editor, Entomology Department, University of Florida, Gainesville. Subscriptions and orders for back numbers are handled by the Business Manager, Box 12425, University Station, Gainesville, Florida 32604. The Secretary can be reached at the same address.

When preparing manuscripts, authors should consult "Instructions to Authors", on the cover of most issues, and examine recent issues for details of form and style.

The page charge is \$10.00 per page, partial pages proportionally. Page charges are scaled upward for articles more than 10 printed pages long. One page of tables is allowed free in every article. Beyond this allowance, tabular matter in excess of 25% of the printed article's length is charged at \$20.00 per page, partial pages proportionally.

Reprints cost 2.5¢ per page for the first 1,500 pages and 1¢ per page thereafter. For example, 200 reprints of a 3-page article total 600 pages; at 2.5¢ per page the charge would be \$15.00. The minimum reprint charge is \$5.00. There are no free reprints of articles of 1 page or longer. Twenty-five free reprints will be provided, if requested, of partial page notes, book reviews, obituaries, etc. No covers for reprints will be provided.
