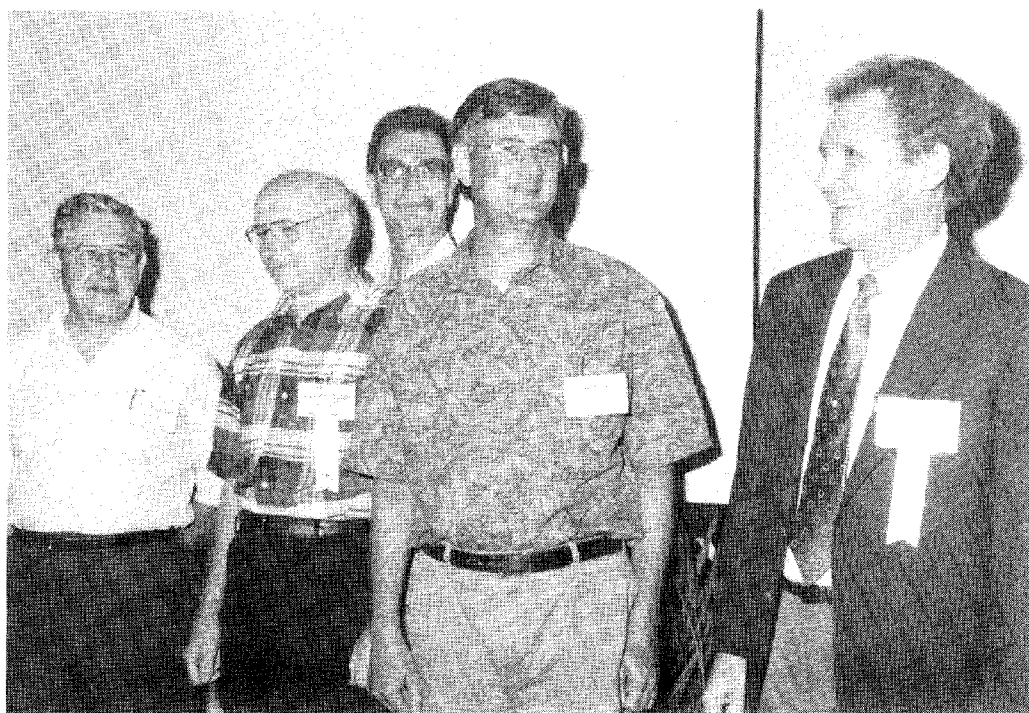


Fig. 1. In-coming President Jorge Peña accepts the gavel from out-going President David Williams.

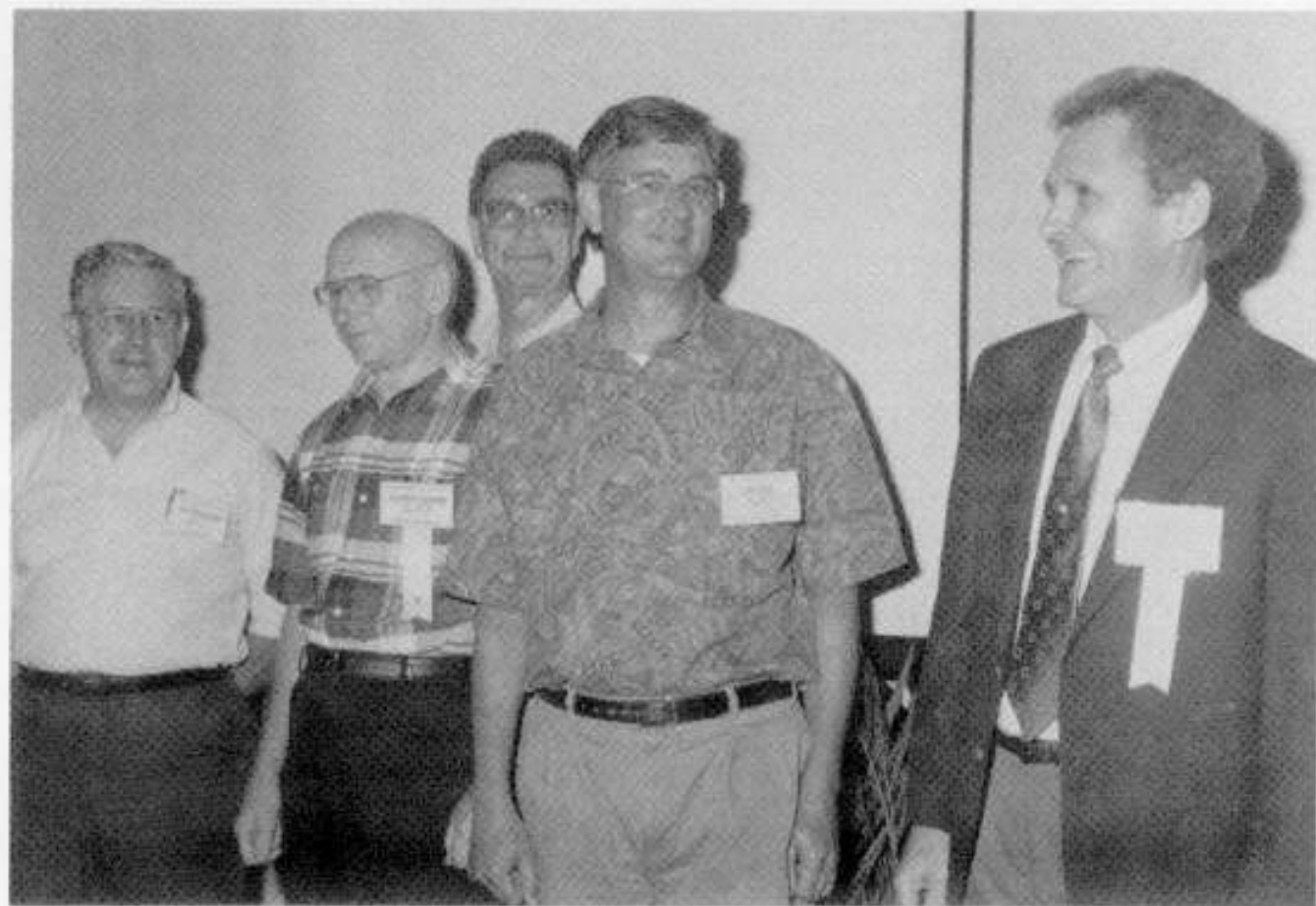
Fig. 14. Participants in the symposium on insect behavioral ecology included (from left to right): J. Sivinski, J. Y. Miller, H. Frank, R. G. Van Driesche, and T. S. Van Hook.
