Richard (Dick) Zeller served as a member of the Florida Society of Geographers (FSG) executive board as the Secretary/Treasurer and was also a significant contributor to FSG for over 25 years. Born August 2, 1948, Dick was one of four siblings born and raised in Fairview Park, Ohio, which is a suburb of Cleveland. Dick received his Ph.D. from Ohio State University and then taught in the Department of Geography at Florida State University from 1980-1986. Dick was employed with the state of Florida's Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles until he passed away on April 4, 2005. Dick touched the lives of not only FSG members, but also his co-workers and the people at the social service agency where he volunteered with the Lutheran Social Services of North Florida.
