



A series of foredune ridges that cap the 6 km of Holocene barrier progradation at Rivoli Bay, South Australia. Each ridge represents a foredune with crests 10-15 m above sea level. The successive foredunes were stranded as the beach prograded between 6-10 ka BP. (24 March 1987, A.D. Short – Coastal Studies Unit, University of Sydney, Sydney, New South Wales, Australia).
