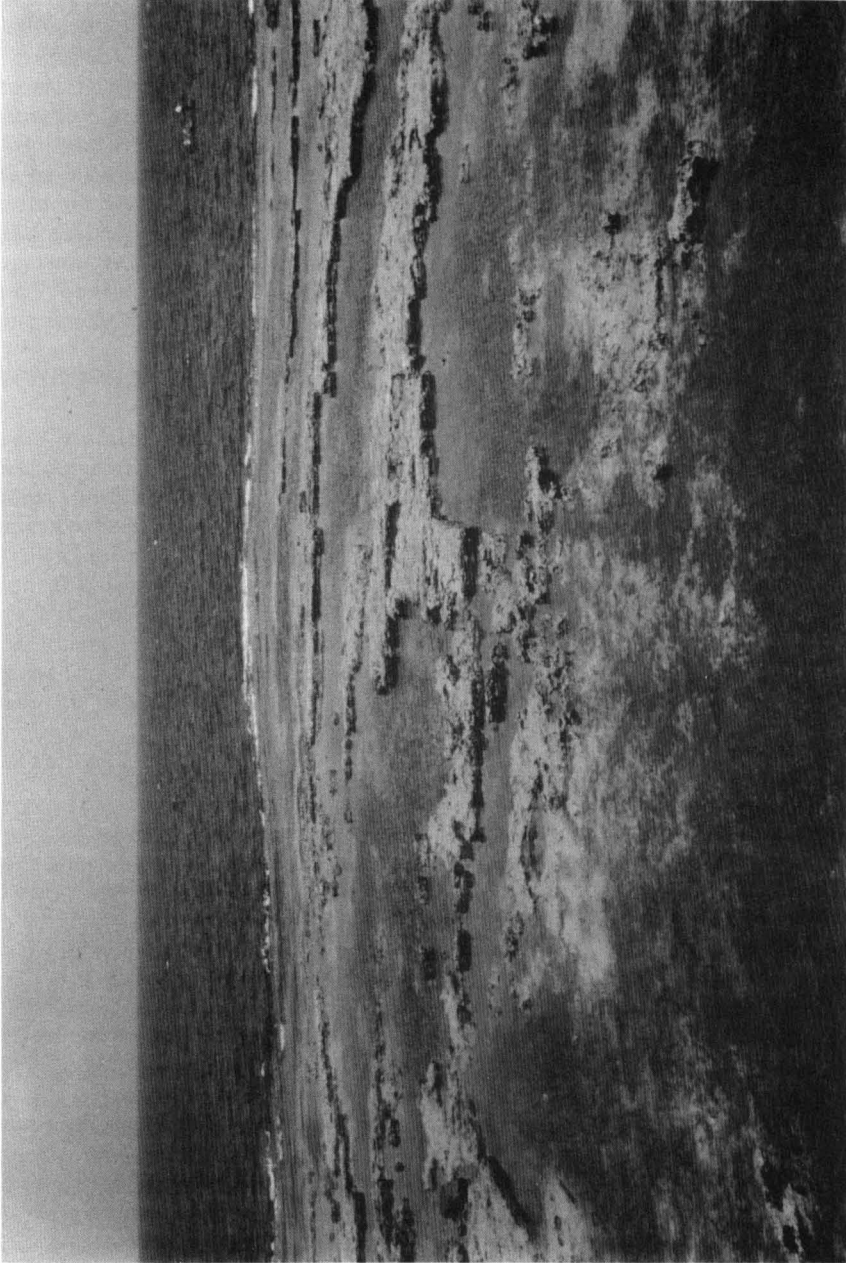


PHOTO 126. Remnants of a Roman quarry near Sidi Daoud, Cape Bon area, Tunisia. Quadrangular blocks were extracted from an upper Pleistocene aeolianite which outcrops along the coast. The floor of the quarry is presently flooded, situation which points to a sea level rise of about a few tens of centimeters since classical Antiquity. (June 23, 1989, R. P.
