

A checklist of the Limnichidae and the Lutrochidae (Coleoptera) of the world

Abstract. A checklist of the world species of Limnichidae (35 genera, 345 species) and Lutrochidae (1 genus, 11 species) is presented. The author, year of publication and page number, synonyms, distribution by country, and a terminal bibliography are given for each genus and species. Biological information is also reviewed.

Introduction

The Limnichidae Erichson (1847) and Lutrochidae Kasap and Crowson (1975) are small semi-aquatic beetles; adults of both families most frequently live in riparian habitats. Both families were previously assigned to the superfamily Dryopoidea (Crowson, 1978); however, they are now placed in the Byrrhoidea (Lawrence and Newton, 1995). From 1975 through 1993, D. P. Wooldridge published numerous limnichid descriptions and revisions but much systematic work remains to be done for the Limnichidae, especially in the tropical regions of the Eastern Hemisphere.

Not much has been published dealing with the biology of the families. Paulus (1970) described the larva of the European species *Limnichus sericeus* Duftschmid (1825) and the larva and pupa of *Pelochares versicolor* Watl (1838). Paulus also reported that the larvae of both genera are terrestrial and live in the soil under the "Chlorophyceae-Bryophyta layers," and reportedly feed on those plants.

Adults may be found near the waterline on branches and grasses hanging over stream banks or in riffles, on driftwood, in logjams, and on rocks in streams; some are found in splash zones beside cascades and waterfalls and on dam breasts. Specimens of at least five limnichid genera, *Pseudeucinetus* Heller (1921), *Martinius* Spilman (1959), *Hyphalus* Britton (1971, 1973, 1977), *Throscinus* LeConte (1874) (fide Wooldridge, 1981), and *Mexico* Spilman (1972) are known to live on coral reefs (Satô, 1997; Hernando and Ribera, 2000b), coastal lagoons, mangrove swamps, or edges of mud or rocky flats along coastal areas.

Brown (1965) discussed characteristic microhabitats of various dryopoids including *Lutrochus* Erichson (1847). Brown and Murvosh (1970) de-

scribed the species and adult behavior of *Lutrochus arizonicus* Brown and Murvosh. Hilsenhoff and Schmude (1992) reported that adults of *L. laticeps* Casey (1893) were found in small to large, warm, calcareous streams; that adults oviposit on submerged wood or on travertine rocks; and larvae were aquatic and were collected on the travertine rocks.

Previous world catalogs that included the limnichids and lutrochids are by Zaitzev (1910) and von Dalla Torre (1911) who recorded 11 genera and 75 species. Blackwelder (1944) published a checklist of the Coleoptera of Mexico, Central America, the West Indies, and South America in which he reported 11 genera and 44 species of Limnichidae and 8 species of Lutrochidae in the nominate genus. Wooldridge (1986b) published a catalog of the Limnichidae (including *Lutrochus*) of North America in which he included 6 genera and 29 species of Limnichidae and the single genus, *Lutrochus* with 3 species. Some recent revisionary studies on the Limnichidae are those by Wooldridge (1976, 1977a, 1977b, 1978, 1979, 1980, 1981b, 1982, 1983, 1987b). Additional studies that have added to our knowledge of the Limnichidae are by Darlington (1936), fauna of the West Indies; Wu (1937), China; Satô (1965), Formosa; Satô (1966, 1976, 1997), Japan; Delève (1968, 1974), Herando and Ribera (2000a), Africa; Delève (1971, 1973), Asia; Wooldridge (1975), Western Hemisphere; Pütz (1991b), Germany; Mascagni (1995), Italy; Pütz (1998a, 1998b), China and neighboring countries; Ribera and Hernando (1999), and Hernando and Ribera (2000b), Oriental Region.

This checklist is an effort to bring the limnichid and lutrochid names and pertinent taxonomic literature into a single publication and was compiled by examining the literature for descriptions, synonyms,

and distributional data plus examination of the collection of the Smithsonian Institution.
